Thanks: Letters of thanks were received from Gwyl (Festival) Blaenau Ffestiniog a'r Fro and Merioneth Young Farmers.

Go Safe: Cllr Thompson had contacted and reported the speeding through the village. An answer was received and a guarantee that a 24 hour observance was in place.

Abergynolwyn Public Toilets: A contract was signed by the Chair and Gwynedd Council to pay £2,000.00 to keep the toilets open from 1st April 2018 to the end of October 2018.

Clerk: It was passed to pay the Clerk the annual fee £1,064.76, plus £100.00 for office/ computer, travelling and petty cash of £347.63 = £1512.39

Donations appeal: Three requests were received, after a discussion it was passed to support Abergynolwyn Silver Band and Welsh Air Ambulance.
