Public Paths: The path from Gamallt to Rhiwlas has one very bad area. It was passed to advise the Highways dept.

One Voice Wales: Cllrs E Evans and E Thompson reported that they had attended a meeting.

Gwynedd Council: Work sheet for January –Resurfacing from Abergynolwyn to the Cemetery.

Precept 2020 - 21: A balance sheet was prepared to the end of December 2019 and an estimated to 31/03/20, showing the unused and over used payments for 2019 -20 and estimated payments for 2020-21.

Estimated expenditure for 2020-21 after receiving the VAT would be £12,294.67. All figures were discussed and it was passed to raise the Precept by 2%, proposed by Cllr Thompson and seconded by Cllr Roberts.
