1. Play area: It was passed to pay for the grass cutting.
2. Cemeteries: It was passed to pay for grass cutting at Llan Cemetery.
3. Paths: It was passed to pay Alwena Jones & Bright on work re path near Maesymeillion.
4. Public Toilets: It was passed to sign the contract between Gwynedd Council and ourselves for two years.
5. Chair Steve Lewis Report: It was noted that the cost of a new defibrillator placed on Y Ganolfan will be £800.00. The work by Gwynedd Council has been carried out near the Ganolfan to protect the Ganolfan when heavy rain takes place. It was noted that the knotweed problem had reoccurred.
