

# LLanfihangel y Pennant Community Council held at Y Ganolfan Abergynolwyn on Monday 11th March 2019

All were welcomed by Vice Chair Steve Lewis, and a special welcome to the Councillor Miriam Webb, who signed a declaration of acceptance of office.

January Minutes were received and signed by chair Steve Lewis

1. Play Area: It was passed to have a site meeting to discuss the play area. It was passed to allow Abergynolwyn Show under the Chairmanship of Jenny Evans to use the play area on July 13th from 2-4. They have their own insurance. Also it was passed to allow the Ganolfan Committee to have their annual Duck Race on the 5th May. They also have their own insurance.
2. Cemeteries: The cemetery book was received from Cllr Robert Jones.
3. Paths: £300.00 was received from Gwynedd Council. It has been confirmed that a tree on a path at the back of Talyllyn Lake had been cut back.
4. Public Toilets: It was passed to agree with Gwynedd Council for the Partnership Plan to cover two years 2019-20 & 2020 -21. We need to push Gwynedd to upgrade and raise the standards of the toilets.
5. Gwynedd Cllr: Cllr Lawton reported that the rates would raise by 5.8%, Police 7.74%. It was noted that the Community Councils were taking the slack. It was noted that to Bylaws were agreed re drainage.
6. Data Protection: Awaiting a local course.
7. Vice Chair S Lewis: explained that he had been in contact with Dylan Jones Traffic Dept., Police and Go Safe, but we still can not have the smaller 30mph signs within the village due to lights been in the village.
8. Financial Regulations: They were accepted with changes suitable to our Council.
9. Clerk's Wages: It was passed to pay the Clerk for the year, plus travelling and petty cash.
10. Thanks: A letter of thanks was received by the Merioneth Young Farmers.

12. Tyres: A report was received about tyres dumped in the Hendre Forestry.
