Play Area: It was passed to pay Sean's Lawns for 28th September. Need to remind Barry Shellis re work on slide.

Cemetery: It was passed to pay Sean's Lawns for September 27th and Les Hopson & Son for the work carried out on the Footpath, this to come from the monies in savings account, urgent work.

Footpaths: No monies to be had from Gwynedd Council re green lane, but the work had to be done. Gwynedd Council working on paths nos. 16 (Llanfihangel y Pennant), no. 18 Abergynolwyn, nos. 35,36,37,38, and 39 Abertrinant.

Gwynedd Councillor report: Cllr Beth Lawton informed us that she was chair of the Standards Committee.

Education: A letter received asking if our representative on Craig yr Adorn School was still eligible to stand. Clerk contacted Cllr Evans, he was happy to stay on the Trustees of Craig yr Aderyn for the next four years, commencing October 2017 – 2021.
