All were welcomed by Chair, and recorded that our thoughts were with Cllr Whitby on the death of her husband.

January minutes were received and signed by chair.

Play Area: The Clerk had a price for tidying up the hedge, spoke with councillors and the work has now been done. It was passed to pay Sean's Lawns.

Cemetery: It was passed to pay Arfon Owen for re opening a grave. Also a day & time was decided to discuss posters at the Llan Church.

Paths: Reimbursement of £300 received from Gwynedd Council. It was agreed that we were happy to carry on with the scheme. Maesymeillion Path – a letter received from Cartrefi Cymunedol Gwynedd, agreeing for us to take it over for £1 plus pay our legal costs.

Gwynedd Cllr: nothing to report

Gwynedd Council: It was passed to ask the Highways to look into the following: -water on road at Tynybryn, Nantmyniawyd, leaves to be removed, Staer Dywyll – trees need clearing and culvert unblocked, Salt bins at Ty Mawr and Rhiw Cwrt need attention, Quarry road and Tanycoed – would like a site meeting .

One Voice Wales: Area meeting 20/2/18. Speeding – no firm result received, various suggestions were put forward and decided to ask P.C.Meirion Jones for a report.

Councillor: No response to the advert, so a notice to say that we will be coopting.

It was passed to pay the internal auditor, and due to his retirement a note of thanks for all his support over the years.

Minffordd light: it was passed to try a simple solar.
