All were welcomed by Chair Elwyn Evans.

1. November Minutes were received and signed by chair Elwyn Evans
2. Play Area: It was passed to pay for repairs to the slide. Only one quote was received for grass cutting, it was passed to keep the cutting of grass to six times a year, a one year contract given. To be assessed and see how it works. The costs of play equipment were discussed and would be on next agenda.
3. Cemeteries: One quote for grass cutting, it was passed to cut the grass at Llan six times a year, the hedge twice, Fedw Cemetery once, weedkiller on the steps and it will be assessed.
4. Paths: It was noted that the new pipe was in place on Quarry Road.
5. Treasurer's Report: The report for 31/12/18 was distributed. All were happy to accept it.
6. Precept 2019 – 2020: The financial report for 2019 -20, prepared by the Clerk, was discussed. With extra costs to be met. It was passed to raise the precept 3% to £11,077.65, with the money in hand to be used for the Play Area. All agreed.
7. Gwynedd Cllr: Beth Lawton: It was noted that Gwynedd Council could raise the rates by 5.5%. The online questionnaire by Gwynedd Council was noted. Work carried out can be affected by cuts. Our thanks Cllr Lawton.
8. Data Protection: Awaiting a local course.
9. One Voice Wales: Chair reported that play area inspection had to be noted. The cemeteries had to be inspected every three months and noted. Any activities on land belonging to the Council had to have their own insurance.
10. Salt Bins: Clerk reported that a second hand bin had been replaced at Ty Mawr Abertrinant. Both bins had been refilled by Highways.
11. External Audit: It was passed to pay and to discuss the report received.
12. Leisure Centres: It was noted that they are run by a new company "Byw'n Iach"
13. Christmas Tree: It was passed to pay on behalf of the Church.
14. Planning Application: 3, Tanybryn Street Abergynolwyn. Listed Building Consent – to remove render to chimney and to insert a lead tray detail prior to rebuild. It was passed to support the application.
15. Section 137(1) & (3) raised to £8.12 per head.
